## Dear Parents/Guardians:

By now you have likely heard about changes to the curriculum in BC schools. The redesigned curriculum for Grades K-9 is being implemented during this school year. As part of this implementation, the Ministry of Education allows schools to pilot different approaches for reporting student progress.

In an effort to communicate more effectively with parents and guardians regarding what students have learned, we are piloting gradeless reporting in most elective courses and Career Education. Instead of one traditional letter grade that is issued for the whole course, teachers will assess and report on student progress in the main curricular competencies and content. We believe that this will give the parents and guardians a greater understanding of their child's progress in a variety of areas within a course. You have the option to request a grade for you child should you choose to do so.

Curricular competencies and content will be reported on using the following scale:
